

GDPR

The GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) takes effect on 25th May 2018. It forms part of the data protection regime in the UK together with the new Data Protection Act 2018. The focus of GDPR is the protection of personal data i.e data about living individuals and below is the Privacy Policy that we, Goldsborough and Flaxby Grouped Parish Council has in place for using and protecting that personal data.

GOLDSBOROUGH & FLAXBY GROUPED PARISH COUNCIL PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy relates to information that we collect from you as an individual and which could identify you or relate to you personally and how we deal with that information and how you can control it.

What we collect and store:

- 1) your name
- 2) your contact information including your email address and telephone number
- 3) your postcode, preferences and interests

What we will not collect and store:

- 1) Sensitive personal data such as health, beliefs, or political affiliations
- 2) Details of any child under 18 without the written permission of their parent or guardian

Reasons to collect your information:

- 1) To communicate with you about the services we offer or about the services you offer
- 2) To advertise your services or activities on our website
- 3) For administrative purposes including maintaining databases of volunteers, allotment holders and specific contacts to assist our obligations and day to day workings as a Parish Council
- 3) To include within Meeting Minutes or general correspondence where the information is relevant and necessary

Controlling your personal information:

If you have provided personal information or want to provide personal information in order to promote or display your services e.g. such as within the Welcome Pack and Newsletter, this Parish Council assumes that this information is freely provided by you to serve your purposes. In addition, you may have simply provided us with your personal contact information so that we can interchange information or just communicate by email, phone or post. However, you may contact the Parish Clerk (refer CONTACT US page on this website or email gboroflaxbypc@gmail.com) at any time to request the alteration or removal of that personal information or how we contact you (email, text, phone-call or post) and this Parish Council will comply with that request promptly.

We will not sell, distribute or lease your personal information to third parties unless we have your permission (by above email or by letter to The Parish Clerk, Ainsty Croft, Main Street, Goldsborough, HG5 8NW)

If you have any questions, believe that any information we hold about you is incorrect or incomplete or you simply want to request details of the personal information that we hold about you please write or email to the addresses provided above. We will deal with your requests promptly.

Cookies:

A cookie is a small file that asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. This website uses cookies to help us provide a better service for you. The cookie helps analyse web traffic and to allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. As such the web application can then tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

A cookie does not give access to your computer or any information about you other than the data you choose to share with us.
