		<b>Report on issues arisen or work undertaken by Goldsborough &amp; Flaxby Parish Council (GFPC) in the period 1st July to 31st July 2020:</b>
<b>A) PLANNING MATTERS</b>		
July	2nd	GFPC received details from HBC (Harrogate Borough Council) of an application for a <b>detached garage at Derry Dell, Midgeley Lane, Goldsborough</b> . GFPC responded to HBC on 26th July querying if the garage front should be in line with the garage of the neighbouring house. HBC's decision is awaited.
	2nd	GFPC received details from HBC of an application for a <b>new driveway entrance gate at Spinney House, Church Street, Goldsborough</b> . GFPC responded to HBC on 26th July querying the height, type and colour for the proposed gate. HBC's decision is awaited.
	5th	GFPC confirmed to HBC of its concerns and objections relating to the reserved matters (amended) application for the <b>36 dwellings next to the Goldsborough Cricket Club</b> . HBC's decision is awaited.
	16th	HBC approved the planning application by <b>Ilke Homes Ltd for the erection of a crane and infrastructure</b> .
	16th	HBC approved the planning application by <b>Ilke Homes Ltd for the retention of 1nr illuminated fascia sign</b> .
	16th	HBC approved the planning application by <b>Ilke Homes Ltd for retention of 165 car parking spaces and laying out of a further 199 car parking spaces</b> .
	17th	HBC approved the reserved matters application by Milner Homes Ltd for <b>1nr dwelling at Flaxby Grange</b> .
	19th	GFPC confirmed to HBC that it had no objections regarding a proposed <b>rear extension to North Barn, 1 East View Court, Goldsborough</b> . HBC's decision is awaited.
	23rd	HBC refused the planning application for a <b>two storey rear extension to Cinder Path Cottage</b> . This was based on siting, scale, mass and design.
